COURSE CONTENTS The Chamber Music study program, an integral part of the instrument course, encompasses the study, rehearsal, and performance of ensemble pieces, carefully selected based on the availability of suitable ensembles, ranging from duos to nonets. In accordance with the Ministerial program, students are required to explore various historical periods over the two-year course, including Classical, Romantic, Modern, and Contemporary music, and to develop chamber music skills in diverse ensemble settings. Regular attendance at the course is mandatory, and students are expected to participate in a sufficient number of rehearsals, in addition to lessons with the instructor, to ensure the successful realization of the chosen pieces.
